Age breakdown of Children Looked After at 31st March (2019-20)





Proportion of Care leavers aged 19-21 who were 'In Touch'








Proportion of Care Leavers aged 19-21 in Suitable Accommodation





*National Reoffending is measured by the Ministry of Justice using PNC data. From October 2017 the MoJ have changed the way reoffending is measured. They are now measuring a cohort of young people who offend within a 3 month period and track them for 12 months. The new measure produces an increase in the rate of reoffending as there is an inbuilt over-representation of prolific young offenders. Previously a prolific young offender would only be counted once in the 12 month cohort they could now be counted up to four times. The MoJ predict that this will lead to a 4-5 percent increase in the reoffending rate.
