Promoting Inclusion

The South East 19 regional Improvement Plan identifies **Inclusion and SEND support in mainstream schools/settings** as an area of focus, to explore good practice and 'what works'

A group of representatives from across the region came together for an initial meeting to share practice and information on how to best support inclusion. The group feels it is important to explore what 'good inclusion' looks like and to work together to agree principles on how to measure positive outcomes.

It was agreed there was no single measure of inclusion. The group will share some of the work that has already been carried out, such as a survey of young people about their experiences. The aim is to create a learning community of practice and be actively involved in identifying, using and sharing inclusive practice with colleagues across all the authorities in the region.
