What will the day involve?

- ❑ A regional focus on national SEND reforms around Inclusion in Mainstream Settings
- ❑ Presentations from inspirational speakers, Schools, SEND Services, Parents and Young People framing the Inclusion Agenda, showcasing good practice and sharing lived experiences
- ❑ Advice, guidance, and facilitation of Local Area Partnership Boards in creating their 'Inclusion Blueprint for Success', building on the learning from the SEND & AP Change Programme and regional good practice, in readiness for SEND Policy Reform
- ❑ An opportunity to contribute to a set of regional principles for progressing and promoting inclusion of CYP with SEND Networking and peer learning opportunities for regional colleagues
