# Content of each live virtual session

The five main live virtual sessions will be 2 hours in total with participatory elements. The three podcasts will be 45 minutes as requested under the apprenticeship pilot. The main sessions will consist of the following:-

Session	Topic	Duration
1	What makes a good EHCP? ( looks at decision making to assess; details of what each section means along the statutory framework; formulation of EHCP; multi-agency working and working with families)	Podcast of 45 minutes
2	SEND legal basics- what does the law say about SEND and how this should be delivered?	Podcast of 45 minutes
3	SEND - school placements and EOTAS/s19	Podcast of 45 minutes
4	Contextual SEND – how does SEND fit in with wider commissioning for children and funding streams ( e.g. children continuing care, mental health acts, wider social care or joint commissioning	Live virtual session 2 hours
5	SEND Tribunals Part 1 –practice and procedure ( including extended appeals,)	Live virtual session 2 hours
6	SEND Tribunals Part 2 including evidence gathering; being a witness and approaches)	Live virtual session 2 hours
7	SEND and mediation – what does the law say and how best to use mediation/alternative resolution	Live virtual session 2 hours
8	SEND and safeguarding/risk	Live virtual session 2 hours



# Content of each live virtual Hot topic session

The hot topics will all be live virtual sessions. They will be an hour long ( 40 minutes presentation and 20 minutes discussion/ Q and A. The topics can be chosen depending on regional themes or specific issues but examples are:-

Session	Topic
1	SEND and when parents disagree or child/parent disagrees – Parental responsibility
2	Private reports and managing these from an commissioning and evidential perspective
3	Ceasing to maintain EHCP's
4	Post 16 considerations.
5	SEND and children/YP with challenging behaviours – looks at specialist placements, working with CAMHS;
